NEWS FROM THE BUSINESS OFFICE

TITHING AND NEEDY FUNDS

Did you know?

The Church maintains a special fund called the "Needy Fund". We normally take an offering around Thanksgiving to support this. From this fund we purchase Scrip gift cards for Walmart (Food) and Kwik trip (gas). During office hours, those in need can stop by to get a gift card along with a resource sheet for local help. We track card distribution, to keep it fair and make sure the program is not being abused. All we ask in return from the recipient is pause and say a prayer with available staff.

The churches (IC and St. Patrick's) also tithe to different charities. You tithe to the church, the church tithes to others. The Finance Councils at both churches help decide who the recipients are each year. A percent of our Adult, Youth and loose weekly collections is allocated to this.

ONLINE GIVING

Did you know that giving online, or setting up auto-pays helps the Church to manage its budget better? When people opt to use these, we see consistent giving, which helps us to better manage our general accounts, which are used for payroll and facilities. Summers are the worst for us, as less people are at Masses, and the bills continue to come in regardless. This is the time of year we normally barely make payroll and sometimes take out a line of credit to cover expenses.

- We know we have a very blended parish when it comes to how you give. Some prefer their box of envelopes at the start of each year and that is totally fine! We have no intention of discontinuing these.
- Then we have those who don't want to use any online systems but would like to have auto-pays done with either their credit card or bank account, that's also fine! We have forms available on our website: Electronic Giving which you can fill out and turn into the office.
- Some choose to use online and mobile tools, provided by "Vanco" (our system of choice for online giving). We have included the instructions (to the right in blue) if you would like to use this method. You can also stop by the Business Office if you want some help setting it up.

What's a QR Code for?

Quick Response codes are scannable codes, which when using the camera on your smartphone will launch you to a website (try scanning this code). We use QR codes

within our Church bulletin (for both IC and St. Patrick's) and sometimes on printed materials to make payments easier. If you have not used Mobile giving in Vanco, you may be asked to set up your account when you scan. Know this is a trusted source the Church is providing. You'll be amazed how simple it is to use.



New Parish Initiative: "Maintenance-to-Mission"

The Parish Evangelization Team for Immaculate Conception and St. Patrick's continues to meet every other week. We begin by spending half an hour together in group prayer. Then we continue discussion, discernment, and work towards what the vision is for our two parishes in ministry and mission. We are tasked to help provide guidance and leadership with the mission of evangelization in our parishes. We are reviewing the ministries and opportunities for faith journey and social outreach to help us better understand what we may be able to do to help support each person in the two parishes in the daily walk of life.

Each of us as a baptized people are called to live a life modeling Christ on earth. An invitation is extended to each of us to live in a discipleship relationship with Jesus through His Church. How fortunate we are as people of God to always have the open standing invitation from God to experience His love if just we open our hearts and ears to Him. We also have the open standing invitation to follow Jesus' example and teachings for a holy life. Jesus was clear that each of us as a sinner is called and welcomed, yes invited, to live in faith. But it is more than private acts of faith. Jesus' words make it clear that we must obey His instructions in the presence of others. It is both as individuals in relationship to one other in our daily life journey as well as in relationship with others in the Catholic Church.
